<p><u>Introduce:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Counting Backwards from 20</li> <li>Skip Counting Practice (5's)</li> <li>Counting Planets</li> </ul> <p><b>Goals:</b> Focus on our counting skills this month by not only counting up by 1's, but by 5's and counting backwards all the way from 20.</p>	<p><u>Introduce:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Spelling/Writing Planet Names</li> <li>Building Space Words</li> <li>Phonetic Letter Sounds a to z</li> </ul> <p><b>Goals:</b> To review and retain learned phonetic letter sounds. Writing out the names of the planets and using magnetic letters to spell space words.</p>	<p><u>Introduce:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>The Phases of the Moon</li> <li>Looking at Constellations</li> <li>What are Planets Made of?</li> </ul> <p><b>Goals:</b> Taking our eyes to the sky and learning different constellations and about how the moon changes throughout the months.</p>	<p><u>Introduce:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Why Does it Get Dark at Night?</li> <li>How does Earth Revolve?</li> <li>Flags of the World</li> </ul> <p><b>Goals:</b> Exploring the concept of night and day and why it happens. Figuring out how Earth and other planets rotate around the sun.</p>
