Carrying and handling materials with care. Using and feeling textures.</p>	<p><u>Introduce:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Holding Pencils Properly • Pouring Materials • Using Scissors/Cutting Practice <p>Goals: Using our hands to complete hold and write with a pencil correctly. Continuing to practice cutting and pouring tasks.</p>	<p><u>Introduce:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Parachute Games • Circle Time Exercises • Walking in a Straight Line <p>Goals: Having fun with the parachute. Moving our bodies during circle time stretched and exercises. Learning how to politely walk in line with friends.</p>
