<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Glue colored squares on a fish (rainbow fish)</li> <li>• Puffer fish painting</li> <li>• Painting seashells</li> </ul> <p><b>Goals:</b> Practice using fine motor coordination while learning about different ocean animals.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Pretend to swim like a shark</li> <li>• Move like a turtle</li> <li>• Pretend to swim like a fish</li> </ul> <p><b>Goals:</b> Practice using large motor muscles and improve gross motor function while using one’s imagination.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Practice using manners (please, thank you, all done) etc.</li> <li>• Practice using eating utensils</li> <li>• Practice taking off and putting on our shoes</li> </ul> <p><b>Goals:</b> Practice daily life skills that promote independence.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Handprint/footprint crab &amp; lobster</li> <li>• Paper plate jellyfish</li> <li>• Paper plate turtle</li> </ul> <p><b>Goals:</b> Use music and art to enjoy learning about ocean animals.</p>
