<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Take turns petting a puppy (stuffed animal) with gentle hands • Take turns brushing/grooming a cat (stuffed animal) • Take turns walking the dog (dog pull toy) <p>Goals: Practice taking turns and developing socially appropriate behaviors.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • “c” for cat • “d” for dog • “f” for fish <p>Goals: Increase vocabulary and letter recognition while learning about house pets.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • House pet colors • Identify striped pets • Identify pets with spots <p>Goals: Review colors, identifying stripes and spots, and improve communication skills.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Listen to different house pet sounds (a dog barking, a cat meowing, etc.) • Make house pets out of play-doh • Wash the dog activity <p>Goals: Use senses to learn about house pets.</p>
