<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Star color matching game • Put star stickers on a letter u: “tracing” • Number space matching game <p>Goals: Learn to match colors and numbers and to “trace” the letter u with stars.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Tell a cooperative story about Space; each child adds on and then draws a picture to make a class book • Talk about Outer Space and take a “rocket trip” • Our classroom star - we work together <p>Goals: Becoming familiar with space by doing cooperative activities and pretending.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Stars in the sky • Our own spaceship; gather materials and work together to make a classroom spaceship • The moon’s surface <p>Goals: Learning about space by learning about the stars in the sky, working together to make a spaceship and the moon’s surface.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Work together to make homemade moon-sand • Galaxy slime • “Star gazing” sensory tub <p>Goals: Learn about space by making different kinds of sensory bins and using the items to better understand space.</p>

Practice following directions.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Scooping out beans and planets with a sifter • Space unit trays with golf tees and marbles (balancing) • Sewing planets, moons and stars <p><u>Review: Washing hands and drying them</u></p> <p>Goals: Develop practical life skills that will help us later in life by doing fun activities that we can do by ourselves.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Planet sun catchers • Make a rocket ship • Puffy planets <p>Goals: To expand creativity using different materials. To listen to directions and follow them. Explore the world around us.</p>
